Opening hours:	9:00 - 16:30. Ticket sales until 30 min. before close time. 9:00 - 19:00 for Apr. 1 - Nov. 30 (every Friday and days of the events in the area). Closing days: Monday (change it on the next day in the case of the national holiday), and end of the year and the new year days.
Admission fees:	500 yen to adults and 250 yen to colledge. High school, junior high school and primary school are free. Group over 20 persons are 400 yen to adults and 200 yen to colledge. Attendance and teaching staffs are free. A disable person is free.
